LOCKING CHURCH DOORS

Because of the continual problems of church doors being left unlocked, the staff has recommended and the deacons have approved the following:

1. That a "push bar" be installed on the back door of the church building located near the water fountains. This would eliminate having to re-lock the same door multiple times.
 2. That a doorbell be installed at the nursery door entrance and used during non-regular church services. This would allow the door to remain locked and nursery workers could see who was coming in.
 3. That a "security team" be formed to walk the premises of the church during church services (am & pm). During the 11:00 am service the security team could begin locking doors as they check the facilities.
 4. That the Family Life Center is re-keyed and the new Family Life Center policy be enacted.
- These changes will be shared at the February church conference.
